Monthly Emergency Drills might include:

- 1) Practice the emergency evacuation of a vehicle as the result of a traffic accident or malfunction.
- 2 Review safety measure used in the transportation of children with chronic medical conditions or behavior concerns.
- 3) Review the documents stored in the transportation binder including the location of the children's identifying information, insurance card and vehicle registration.
- 4) Review the procedures for use of emergency supplies stored on the vehicle; i.e., fire extinguisher, first aid kit, reflector triangles, device to cut restraints.
