(4) Prescription and nonprescription medication shall be administered to a childcare:

(a) 1. With written request of the child's parent or the child's prescribing health professional; and 2. According to the directions or instructions on the medication's label.

(b) In accordance with KRS 311.646.

(5) The child-care center shall keep a written record of the administration of medication, including:

(a) Time of each dosage;

(b) Date;

(c) Amount;

(d) Name of staff person giving the medication;

(e) Name of the child; and

(f) Name of the medication.

Adverse reactions to medication should be reported immediately to the parent and recorded on the back of this form



Adverse reactions to medication

If a child has an adverse reaction to a medication:

- 1) Contact the parent/guardian immediately
- 2) Document the adverse reaction and steps taken

(3) If a child becomes ill while at the child-care center:

(a) The child shall be placed in a supervised area isolated from the rest of the children;

(b) The parent shall be contacted immediately; and

(c) Arrangements shall be made to remove the child from the child-care center as soon as practicable.
