

KENTUCKY ALL STARS TRAINING STANDARDS

There are three required All STARS training standards for all programs that are Level 2 and above, and two optional All STARS training standards that can be used to help achieve a higher level.

Required Training Standards – Level 2 and Above

Standard	Who Needs It?	When?	Other Notes
A1R: 50% of teaching staff have professional learning activities in developmental screening.	50% or more of teaching staff	Training must be taken within prior certification period (or last 3 years).	Director can be included if regularly scheduled in ratio.
B1R: Program site administrator/director receives 10 hours of professional learning in curriculum, instructional practices or teaching and learning OR has an approved early childhood credential or degree.	Director	Training must be taken within prior certification period (or last 3 years). If credential used, must be current.	Must be onsite director responsible for day-to-day operations.
B2R 50% of teaching staff receive 10 hours of professional learning in curriculum, instructional practices or teaching and learning OR have an approved early childhood credential or degree.	50% or more of teaching staff	Training must be taken within prior certification period (or last 3 years). If credential used, must be current.	Director is included in B1R so is not counted here unless sole provider.

Optional Training Standards - To Help Achieve Higher Level

Standard	Who Needs It?	When?	Other Notes
B5: 50% of teaching staff participate in professional learning activities related to curriculum-based assessment.	50% or more of teaching staff	Training must be taken within prior certification period (or last 3 years).	Director can be included if regularly scheduled in ratio.
C1: Program/site administrator and 75% of (all) staff complete professional learning activities related to strengthening family engagement.	Director <i>and</i> 75% or more of all staff	Training must be taken within prior certification period (or last 3 years).	All staff, not just teaching staff, are included in totals.
