From EKU TRIS to COLT: Modernizing the DCBS Learning & Training Experience Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

This guide will be your one-stop-shop for understanding the broader transformation effort that is already underway. We are beginning to move content from our current EKU TRIS platform to a new KY TRIS environment, and eventually to a modernized system called the Commonwealth Offerings for Learning and Training (COLT).

What is a Learning Management System (LMS)?

A platform that enables online education by providing a framework to create, manage, deliver, and record learning content.

What LMS does KY DCBS currently use?


KY DCBS currently utilizes a TRIS platform operated by Eastern Kentucky University (EKU).

What is KY DCBS changing about the EKU TRIS LMS?

KY DCBS is in the process of migrating data from EKU TRIS to KY TRIS, an in-house system managed by DCBS. The final goal is to transition to COLT, an advanced LMS that is already in use across the Commonwealth.

Will there be any changes to the LMS functionality?

As of now, you should not see any changes with the system, but we anticipate updates down the road as we modernize the platform. However, it is important to note that until further notice, you should continue utilizing the EKU TRIS platforms. Our blackout period will be from June 13th to July 31st. We will provide updated guidance about operations and expectations during that system outage before it begins.



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
