C2	Family & Community Engagement	2 points maximum	Implements family engagement activities that promote children's development and learning. - Implements at least one family engagement activity per year that promotes children's development and learning. (1pt) -Implements at least three family engagement activities per year that promote children's development and learning. (2pts)	Family engagement activities that promote children's development and learning: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May introduce screening during orientation or family event (tip sheet of options are shared with centers after enrolled) • Parents complete the online screen • Meeting is held with parent to discuss results • Learning activities are shared with families to practice until next screen • They will offer screening twice per year or more

C5	Family & Community Engagement	1 point	Shares community resources with families	Community referral resources are shared during the parent conference to discuss screening results.
C6	Family & Community Engagement	1 point	Builds partnerships with community agencies	Help Me Grow is considered a community agency via being within the Division of Child Care. Agreeing to utilize this program is building a partnership with DCC and therefore would meet this standard.
